May 1 Jenny Francholt & Albert Johnson Diversity Scholarship – Seniors planning on attending UC Berkeley and considered an underrepresented minority – being a member of one of the following groups; Native American, African American, Chicano/Latino, Pacific Islander, Southeast Asian, Multiethnic , AB540 friendly, and/or disabled.

May 5 Seiji Isomoto Scholarship Fund – Seniors of Asian-American descent with a 3.0 GPA in all academic classes, excluding physical education and service. Students must have lettered in a high school VARSITY sport and be college bound.

May 11 CSE Youth Automobile Safety Scholarship – Seniors with a minimum GPA 3.0 and plan to attend a two-or four-year college or university, or trade school. Applicant's parent or legal guardian must be currently employed full-time by-or if retired or deceased, must have been employed full-time by-a government entity. May 31 Hano Uno Shepard Memorial Scholarship – Seniors who come from a single-parent family of Japanese ancestry. Applicants will be chosen on their scholastic merit, outside activities and general financial need.

June 1 Clarkson University Leadership and Achievement Awards Program – Juniors who demonstrate outstanding leadership qualities, have an academic interest in Engineering, Business, Science or Liberal Arts. Be recognized by students and faculty as having been a positive contributor to

your school and community. Also be ranked in the top 15%. Must be nominated by a counselor.
